

## **Visitation Plan, Rules and Policies**

This following is pending certain guidelines are met including team members and residents are covid-19 free for 14 days as well as maintain infection control practices.

- 1. Family visit times are between the hours of 9am-5pm 7 days a week.
- 2. Due to initial volume visit times are limited to 30 minutes per family.
- 3. To ensure the health and safety of residents as well as team members and ensure social distancing is maintained there will be a maximum of 2 families at one time, with a maximum of 2 members from each family for outdoor visits and 1 family at one time, with a maximum of 2 members for indoor visits.
- 4. There will 15-minute break in between each visit to clean and disinfect visitation areas.
- 5. Families will request appointments via Caremerge, and appointments will be scheduled on the Caremerge appointments calendar. For those who do not have Caremerge please call Octavius Deleon Sunday-Thursday from 8:30am-4:30pm to make a reservation.
- 6. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance.
- 7. Families will call the community 10 minutes before reservation time so we may assist the resident to the designated reservation area.
- 8. Temperature and screening will be taken at the front of the community before going into the back yard. If you are exhibiting any signs or symptoms, please do not visit.
- 9. If the family has traveled to any of the states with current NYS travel restrictions, they will not be permitted to visit at the community if they can not provide proof that they have quarantined for 10 days prior.
- 10. Families will need to then walk around to the back of the community to meet the resident.
- 11. All families and residents are to wear a mask. Please arrive wearing your own mask. Should families require a mask one will be provided.
- 12. Upon arrival you will be guided to the designated area where you and your loved one may sit to visit. Please do not walk around with your loved one.
- 13. All families and residents must always maintain physical distancing (6 feet).
- 14. Please do not bring outside supplies or food items as they will need to be disinfected.
- 15. Any outside supplies must continue to go through the front desk.
- 16. Water will be provided. Please do not bring any outside beverages.
- 17. Please do not bring any pets to your family visits.
- 18. A member of the Brielle team will always be with you in the back yard to assist you and your loved one as well as to answer any questions.
- 19. Visitors will not be permitting into the community for any reason this includes utilizing rest rooms.
