Visitation Plan, Rules, and Policies

1. There are no day/time limitations for visits.
2. There is no limit on time for visits.
3. There is no limit on the number of visitors in a resident's room. However, to ensure the health and safety of residents we ask that you maintain safe social distancing (6 feet) for the duration of your visit.
4. Visitors must maintain safe social distancing from other residents and team members.
5. Temperature and screening will be taken at the front desk at the kiosk when you walk into the community before going to your visit. If you are exhibiting any signs or symptoms, please do not visit.
6. All visitors and residents are to wear a mask. Please arrive wearing a mask. Should visitors require a mask one will be provided to you.
7. If your loved one resides in our Memory Care community, you will be escorted to the floor after signing in at the kiosk. If your loved one resides in Assisted Living, you may go to your loved one's apartment after signing in on your own.
8. We ask that all visitors please sign out at the kiosk before leaving.
9. All clothing should continue to go to the front desk before going to the resident's room.
10. Please do not bring any pets to your family visits unless it is cleared through a manager prior to your visit with vaccination records on file in the community.
11. If you are doing outdoor visits, please notify a member of The Brielle team and we will notify you where you may enjoy your visit.
12. Visitors will not be permitted into the community common areas; this includes utilizing rest rooms.
